Directions:- Use your favoured route to get to Kingsclere. Head south out of Kingsclere on the B3051 towards Overton. After 2km at the top of the hill turn left in to the car park. (White Hill). The NE bowl is west of the car park about 600M. Access is over the road and along the track. Take the right hand track at the Concrete garage (roofless) and follow the fence slope side.

Head north into Kingsclere and turn left onto the A339. Head towards Newbury. ¾ Km after the roundabout the Star Inn is on your left.

Directions:- Use your favoured way to get to Leydene Park on the Droxford Road SE of West Meon. If you take the A32 from Alton to West Meon. Drive through West Meon and take the left fork onto Station Road. This becomes Old Winchester Hill Road. About 4 miles from West Meon you will come to a 'village' with a dog leg. Turn left here onto the Southdown way track. After approx. 500M you come to a barn on your left, a farm on your right and two aerials. Just pass the farm turn right through the gate and put your £1 in the blue box. Drive approx. 200M along the fence towards the copse and park next to the fence. The site is shared with hang gliders.
